GreenSchool

Transforms public schools into social ventures that generate photovoltaic and agricultural wealth in order to improve the living and studying conditions of students.

Ecolibree

Fights against school dropout and advocates for health and wellness by providing young girls in marginalized areas with hygienic and ecological menstrual panty kits.

3- Our Achievements:

ENERGY

- 140 solar panels and 50 solar water heaters installed
- Insulation and waterproofing of buildings
- Compliance of electrical installations

AGRICULTURE

- 8 hectares of cultivated land and a 200 m2 greenhouse
- 9 parents employed in compliance with labor laws
- 150 tons of fruits and vegetables harvested per year

EDUCATION

- 12 extracurricular clubs (entrepreneurship, coding, women's basketball...)
- 1 multi-sport field
- 1 cinema room
- 1 E-learning room

HEALTH

- Training and sensitization on menstruation matters
- 15,000 washable sanitary pants distributed
- Production of washable sanitary kits
